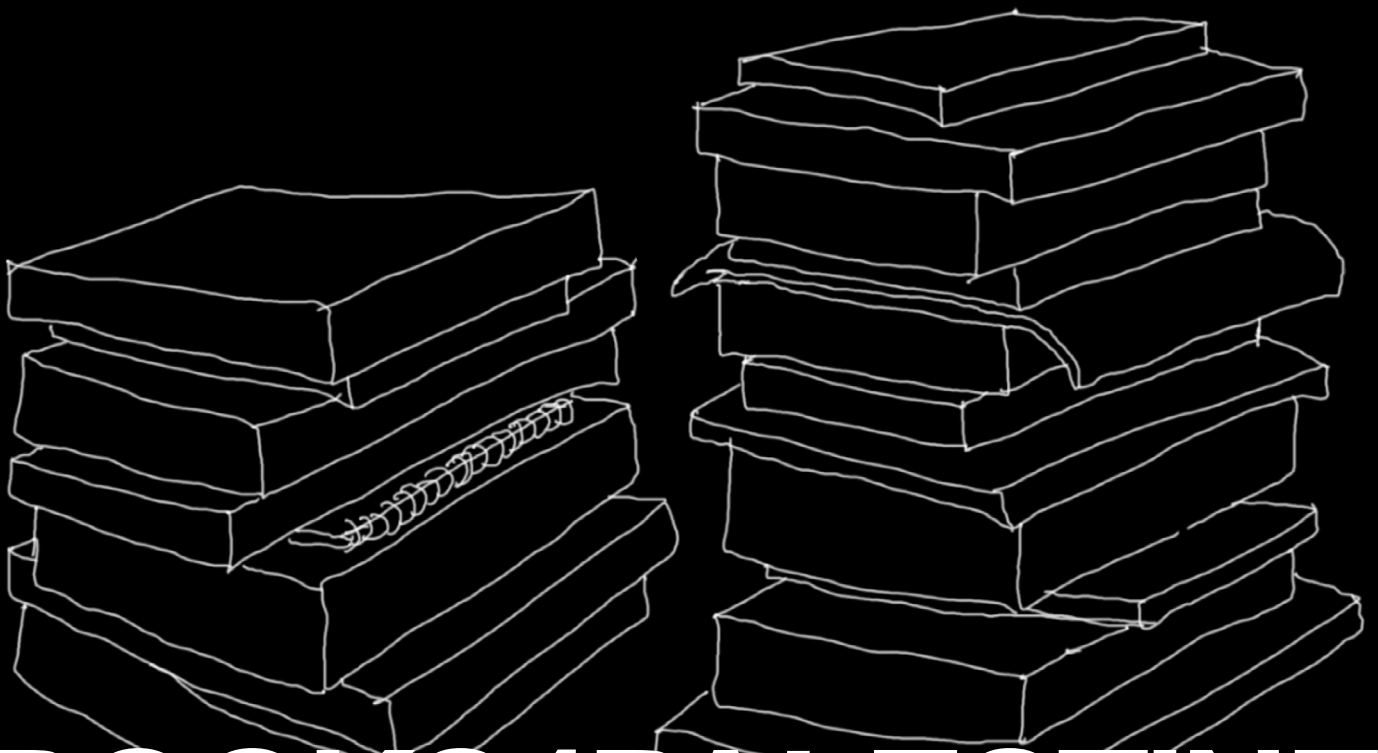

About

BOOKS4PALESTINE is a fundraising campaign to support Palestine through book sales.

The goal of this campaign is to raise funds through the sale of books donated by publishers and authors/artists like you who wish to support the Palestinian cause.

All proceeds from the sale will be donated to Sanad, a Palestinian cooperative that provides hot meals for the displaced population of the Gaza Strip.

The fundraising is organised by *meta*, supported by *C/SS*, in favour of *Sanad*.

Image Guidelines 1/3

We need at least the cover image in order to display your book in the website. The main image can be a jpg or png file of the book cover. Doesn't need to be a professional photo. The cover image can be extract from the design file or a screenshot from the print pdf. Long side min 2000 px.

If you don't have neither the print file or a pdf please just scan the book flat at a copy center shop.

Image Guidelines 2/3

Rename Images:

In order to help us archive images and upload them correctly to the website, we kindly ask you to rename each image using a specific format.

Format:

first 4 letters of your email - first author's name - book's title

Example:

mail: yourmail@mail.com author: Lena Huber and Mark Takoyama title: The first book	→	your-Lena Huber-The first book
--	---	--------------------------------

if you are donating more than one book you will add a number starting from 1 after your 4 email's letter:

mail: yourmail@mail.com author: Lena Huber and Mark Takoyama title: The first book	→	your1-Lena Huber-The first book

mail: yourmail@mail.com author: Jack Self and Claudia Forster title: The second book	→	your2-Jack Self-The second book

if you are donating one or more books with more than one images add a letter after the number starting from a to z:

Questions of Labour—a publication structured around five questions—deals with the contemporary, late-capitalist circumstances of labour in the fields of arts and culture. The publication critically examines themes such as self-entrepreneurship, immaterial labour, neoliberalism, financialisation, automation and the future of work, and our relationship to rest and sleep. The publication is comprised of artistic and literary responses from 18 contributors.

Questions of Labour—publication is the result of a similarly titled university course held at Aalto University (Finland) in 2020.

Shipping

Books will be shipped directly from the book donor to the person who buys the book, in order to avoid unnecessary expenses and travel. The cost of shipping will be reimbursed to the book donor after the purchase.

On the website, we will offer one shipping option that costs 10 € for everybody. We tried to make an average of shipping costs and balance out domestic and within Europe.

Domestic shipping within the same country for thin packages, such as books, is usually inexpensive. Ask your local post office about the available options or find a shipping service that offers rates similar to those mentioned above.

Donations

Those who donate books to BOOKS4PALESTINE agree to allocate 100% of the proceeds from their donations. Donors will provide a suggested selling price for each book they contribute. Users will see a suggested minimum price (set by previous donors), to which the shipping cost will be added at checkout. For example, if the price suggested by the donor is €20, users will see: “Donation starting from: €20,” with the shipping cost added at the checkout page.

Shipping costs are calculated based on the average of various available services. When a book is sold, 100% of the net proceeds (excluding transaction fees) will be donated to Sanad to support the Palestinian population.

The entire BOOKS4PALESTINE team and all those involved work on a voluntary basis and do not receive any payment or percentage of the donations.

Goals

According to data released by the United Nations, 91% of the population in Gaza, including girls and boys, go hungry due to extreme lack of food.

More than 96 percent of boys and girls aged 6-23 months and women do not meet their nutritional needs due to lack of a minimum diversified diet.

It is projected that by 2025, about 60,000 boys and girls will need treatment for acute malnutrition.

With 1000 euros we will be able to buy enough rice, lentils, oil, spices, vegetables and broth to prepare 8 piñatas/pots equivalent to 3000 family servings (3076 for precision).

The cost also covers labor, transportation, clean water and wood needed for cooking.

Distributions will be made in the Central (Deir el Balah) and South (Khan Younis) areas of the Gaza Strip.

The above prices may change due to the unstable situation inside the Gaza strip.
